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PREPARE

GET READY for Communion and Giving.

1. Get your **COMMUNION** elements ready now. Use unleavened bread if available. If not, use a tortilla or crackers. Last choice should be leavened bread. Use grape juice or wine if available.
2. Get your **GIVING** ready now. If you give electronically via The Realm or gracelr.com, get that device ready. If you send in a check, then prep that as well.

What is changing?
